

ADMINISTRATION OF PHIL IRI POST READING TEST SY 2023-2024

To: All Teaching and Non-Teaching Personnel  
All others concerned

1. In line with Division Memorandum No. 294, s. 2024, titled "Administration of the Rapid Math Assessment (RMA), Comprehensive Literacy Assessment (CRLA), Philippine Informal Reading Inventory (PHIL-IRI) and Division Numeracy Assessment (DNA) for End-of-School Year (EOSY) 2023-2024, this office informs the administration of **PHIL-IRI Post Reading Test (GST and Oral Passages)** for both English and Filipino from **April 29-May 10, 2024**.
2. The GST and oral passage for Grade 7 shall be taken from the **Philippine Informal Reading Inventory Manual 2018**, while the validated passages for GST and oral passages for Grades 8 to 10 shall be accessed from the link provided by SDO General Trias City ([https://bit.ly/Phil-IRI\\_LocalizedPassages](https://bit.ly/Phil-IRI_LocalizedPassages)).
3. Only learners who obtained a raw score of **below 14** in the GST will be included in the oral reading using the Individual Graded Passages. Kindly consult the PHIL-IRI Manual for the specific procedure.
4. The administration of the GST and the Graded Oral Passages shall be primarily done by the **English subject teacher**. However, **Homeroom advisers** and other **subject teachers** may also be tapped to administer the said assessment, provided that they have been oriented on the process of doing the post reading assessment.
5. Results of the PHIL IRI Post test shall be submitted to the reading focal persons on or before **May 15, 2024**.
6. English and Filipino teachers are expected to record the result of pre-reading test using the forms found in the Philippine Informal Reading Inventory Manual 2018.
  - a. PHIL-IRI Form 1A- Talaan ng Pangkatang Pagtatasa ng Klase (TPPK)
  - b. PHIL-IRI Form 1B- Screening Test Class Reading Record (STCRR)
  - c. Other forms used for testing using Graded Oral Passages for learners who got a score of below 14.
